Privacy notice for customers and suppliers regarding the processing of personal data, pursuant to Article 13 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018, and to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679. Mario Cucchetti Tessuti S.r.l., with registered office at Via Novara 14 – 21053 Castellanza (VA), Tax Code and VAT No. 00181680125 (hereinafter, the "Data Controller"), in its capacity as Data Controller, hereby informs you pursuant to Art. 13 of Legislative Decree 196/03, as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018 (hereinafter, the "Privacy Code"), and to Art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation EU 679/2016 (hereinafter, the "GDPR") that your data will be processed in the following ways and for the following purposes.

1. Subject of the processing

The Data Controller processes the personal and identifying data (e.g. first name, last name, company name, address, telephone number, e-mail, banking and payment details) – hereinafter, "personal data" or simply "data" – which you have communicated in the course of pre-contractual activities or upon the conclusion of contracts for the supply of goods and/or services of the Data Controller.

2. Purposes of the processing

Your personal data are processed without the need for your express consent (Art. 24(a), (b), (c) of the Privacy Code and Art. 6(b), (e) of the GDPR), for the following Contractual Purposes: to conclude contracts for the supply of goods and/or services of the Data Controller; to fulfil the pre-contractual, contractual and tax-related obligations arising from existing relationships with you.

– **Administrative and accounting purposes.** For the purposes of applying the rules on the protection of personal data, processing carried out for administrative and accounting purposes is the processing connected with the performance of activities of an organisational, administrative, financial and accounting nature, irrespective of the nature of the data processed. In particular, such purposes include internal organisational activities, those functional to the fulfilment of contractual and pre-contractual obligations, to the management of the employment relationship in all its phases, to bookkeeping and to the application of tax, trade-union, social-security/welfare, health, hygiene and workplace-safety regulations.

– **Informational and promotional purposes.** The use of e-mail contact details supplied by the customer in the context of the sale of a product or service, for the purposes of direct sale of the Data Controller's own products or services, is permitted for the purpose of sending information notices

and newsletters. The data subject, at the time of collection and on the occasion of each communication, is informed of the possibility of objecting at any time to such processing, easily and free of charge (Art. 130 paragraph 4 of Legislative Decree 196/03). To unsubscribe from the mailing list, it is sufficient to write at any time to the e-mail address info@mariocucchetti.it or by post to the physical address of the Data Controller indicated above (registered office), with the subject line "mailing list unsubscription".

– **Safety, pursuant to Legislative Decree 81/2008.** With particular reference to the identifying data freely provided by guests/visitors at our premises (first name, last name, organisation or company of belonging), the processing has the exclusive purpose of ensuring compliance with the corporate security procedures formally applied, also in accordance with the legal provisions in force (e.g. entry in the visitors' register/database, assignment of a temporary identification badge, application of legal obligations on workplace safety).

– **To exercise the rights of the Data Controller and the right of defence in legal proceedings.**

3. Methods of processing

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of the operations indicated in Art. 4 of the Privacy Code and in Art. 4 no. 2) of the GDPR, namely: collection, recording, organisation, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, erasure and destruction of data. Your personal data are subject to both paper-based and electronic and/or automated processing.

The Data Controller will process the personal data for the time necessary to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes and, in any event, for no longer than 10 years from the end of the relationship for Service Purposes, and for no longer than 5 years from the collection of the data for informational and promotional purposes.

4. Access to data

Your data may be made accessible, for the purposes referred to in paragraph 2 of this document, to:

- employees and collaborators authorised by the Data Controller;
- Data processors and System Administrators appointed by the Data Controller; third-party companies or other entities (by way of example, banks, professional firms, consultants, insurance companies for the provision of insurance services, third-party technical-service providers, postal couriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies, etc.) that carry out outsourced activities on behalf of the Data Controller, appointed, where necessary, as data processors;
- entities that provide services for the management of the information system used by the Data Controller and of the telecommunications networks, and which see to the maintenance of the technological component (including e-mail and the newsletter service);
- self-employed professionals, firms or companies in the context of assistance and consultancy relationships;

- entities that carry out control, auditing and certification activities concerning the activities performed by the Data Controller; competent authorities for the fulfilment of legal obligations and/or orders issued by public bodies, upon their request. Your data may additionally be processed, on behalf of the Controller, by professionals and/or companies engaged to carry out technical, development, management and administrative–accounting activities.

5. Data transfer

The Data Controller processes personal data by adopting the appropriate security measures aimed at preventing unauthorised access, disclosure, modification or destruction of personal data. The processing is carried out by means of IT and/or electronic tools, with organisational methods and logic strictly related to the indicated purposes.

Personal data are processed at the registered office of Mario Cucchetti Tessuti S.r.l., at the operational office and by means of servers made available by third-party providers and located within the European Union; for further information please contact the Data Controller. It remains in any case understood that the Data Controller, should it become necessary, shall have the right to relocate the servers outside the EU as well. In such a case, the Data Controller hereby assures that the transfer of data outside the EU will take place in compliance with the applicable legal provisions, upon prior conclusion of contracts providing for the methods set out in Chapter V of the GDPR.

6. Nature of the provision of data and consequences of refusal to respond

As regards the data we are required to know in order to fulfil the obligations arising from existing contracts and the obligations imposed by laws, regulations, EU legislation or orders issued by the Authorities legally empowered thereto and by supervisory and control bodies, failure to provide such data will result in the impossibility of establishing or continuing the relationship, to the extent that such data are necessary for its performance. The provision of data to enable the Data Controller to send commercial communications is optional; the data subject may object at any time to such processing, easily and free of charge. 7. Rights of the data subject

In your capacity as data subject, you have the rights set out in Articles 15–21 of the GDPR, and specifically: to obtain confirmation as to whether or not data exist, to know their content and origin, to verify their accuracy, to request their integration, updating, rectification or erasure, the restriction of processing, portability, and to object, on legitimate grounds, to their processing. Where applicable, you also have the right to be forgotten, as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority.

8. Methods of exercising the rights


You may exercise your rights at any time by sending:
